



Dear Parents/Carers

Following my communication on Friday, it is clear that the forecast extreme weather conditions are set to impact upon our local area and, in line with other local secondary schools, to best support the safety of students and staff we have taken the decision to revert to remote learning for Monday 18 & Monday 19 July 2022.

On both Monday and Tuesday lessons will be delivered remotely via Teams following the normal timetable. Online morning registration will take place with Tutors at 8.35am.

Students will be required to log in to satchel for lesson details and Teams links and lessons will be made up of live teaching and independent learning, which students will be required to complete. Work will be set on Satchel and students should access this through their usual log in.

As the weather forecast predicts that temperatures will drop significantly on Wednesday 20th July, all students should return to the school as normal at registration time.
